REHABILITATION OF UNDERGROUND TANKS PROJECT:

Introduction

RACIDA has worked in Mandera County for more than 17 years and has focused on building the resilience of rural pastoralists' communities in the County. This is in line with the organization's core mandate of enhancing self-reliance and prosperity amongst vulnerable pastoralist communities through the promotion of better livelihood systems and sustainable use of natural resources. In this project, RACIDA is working toward achieving a lasting impact on the social and economic development of the targeted communities in Mandera County by implementing activities in WASH; agriculture and food security; and nutrition.

To address the vulnerability of pastoralist populations in Mandera County, it is important to focus more on improving agricultural production with a focus on livestock, water, and crop production as critical sectors forming the foundation of addressing disaster risk reduction in the County and supporting recovery. To this end, it is important that the Project focus on building the capacity of the affected communities including community institutions such as Water User Associations/Water committees and Solar Operators. This project will focus on rehabilitating existing water infrastructure, undertaking livestock disease control, and Hygiene promotion campaigns "To mitigate the effects of the drought and support community-led early recovery efforts for targeted communities in Mandera County through improved access to water, household purchasing power, and improved livestock health. RACIDA will work closely with local stakeholders including the County government of Mandera through the Ministry of Water, Livestock, and Agriculture.

<u>REHABILITATION OF THREE UNDERGROUND WATER TANKS IN MANDERA NORTH &</u> <u>BANISSA SUB-COUNTIES, MANDERA COUNTY</u>

Communities in Mandera County, Kenya, have faced significant economic and social crises due to recurrent conflict and climatic shocks. Since 2019, the County has been exposed consecutively to drought, conflict, multiple locust invasions, and more recently, in 2020, COVID-19. The failure of sequential rains through 2020 across Mandera has negatively impacted livestock productivity and household purchasing power for these communities whose primary livelihood is pastoralism. Responses to recurrent shocks have been slow, and communities have exhausted their local coping strategies, pushing them to rely on humanitarian aid. There are currently an estimated 216,864 people in need of humanitarian assistance including, access to water, food, Nutrition, WASH NFIs, fodder for livestock, and livestock vaccinations.

To address the pre-identified community needs, RACIDA is implement an integrated response to the triple crisis of drought, desert locusts, and COVID-19 (IETC) by leveraging complementary interventions across WASH, nutrition, and agriculture sectors. The IETC project activities will improve livestock livelihoods by improving livestock disease surveillance, vaccinations, and access to fodder and water. Simultaneously, RACIDA is

supporting improved access to water supply and hygiene services by rehabilitating water points, providing key hygiene messages and WASH NFIs. Water supply rehabilitation will also support health facilities that IETC is supporting with integrated WASH and nutrition activities.

To mitigate the effects of droughts and to protect the communities in Mandera North and Banissa from impacts of future droughts. Through this project, underground water tanks of 400 cubic meters will be rehabilitated in remote water-stressed locations where the only water source for drinking water is water pans. Communities use other sources of water such as earth pans throughout the normal period until they've been exhausted. Currently, when pans dry up, communities rely on water trucking. Therefore, the proposed underground tanks will act as reservoirs to be used only during critical times of drought, so communities usually oversee the use of the underground tanks during the drought period which is the only time they become accessible. This practice has been ongoing in our target communities. The underground tanks in this project are expected to terve 1500HHs (9000 individuals) with safe drinking water (about 7.5 litres/persons/day) for an extended period of at least 40 days.

To reduce the possibility of contamination, the surface runoff will be channeled into an inlet and then to a silttrap before flowing into the tank. Also, the Barkads will be roofed to reduce contamination and evaporation of water in the tank. RACIDA will put up a fence around the tank to restrict animals and for safety purposes, especially for children. Piping will be done from the Barkads to the village water collection points. Most Barkads are constructed a distance away from the settlement. A small solar power pump will be installed in each of the Barkads, through 10,000 liters elevated PVC water tank located near the Barkads and will also be installed with four taps for ease of fetching water and under the taps a small slab will be constructed. Water will be treated at the PVC tank by trained water user association members. One 10,000 liter PVC tank will be treated with a total of 10 aqua tabs (86.8gms). One aqua tab is 8.68gms and can disinfect 1000-1,250 liters of water. Water users will be trained on how to read a comparator and measure chlorine residual levels that will determine re-chlorination. According to WHO's water safety standards, when chlorine levels reach 0.2 to 0.5mg/l, water users will need to re'-chlorinate. This will ensure community members are able to access safe water for household use.
